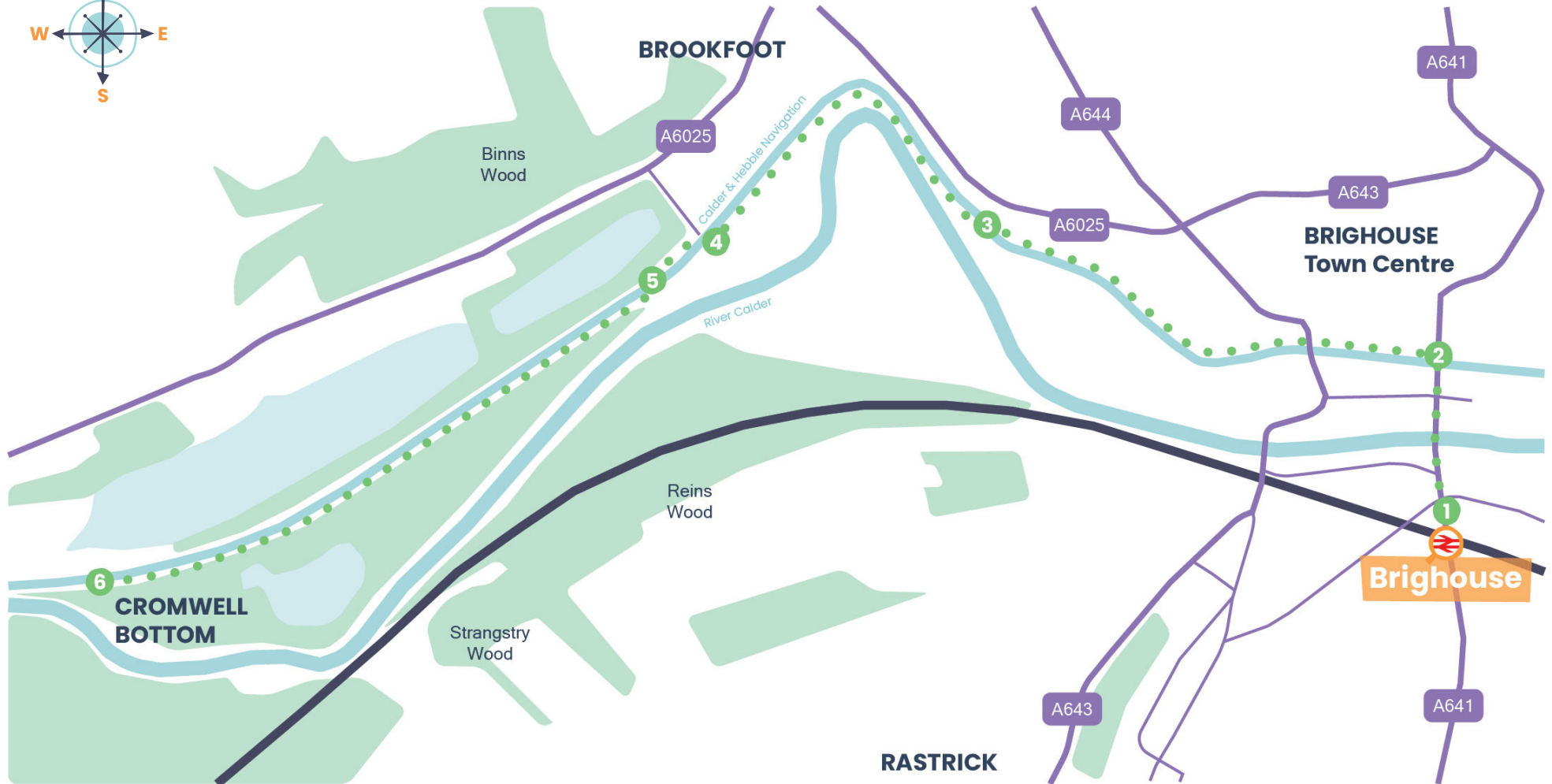
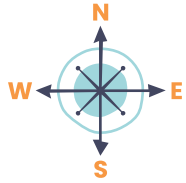
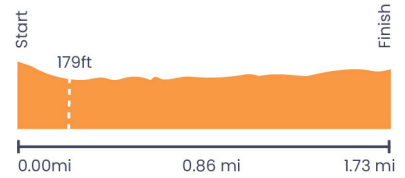


Brighouse to Cromwell Bottom

Brighouse to Cromwell Bottom

A simple walk from Brighouse railway station, with the option to take advantage of the towns amenities. This route mainly follows the canal towpath of the Calder & Hebble Navigation to the nature reserve of Cromwell Bottom.

- 1 Exit the Brighouse Station and head north on the A641 crossing the river Calder.
- 2 Turn left onto the canal towpath and follow for approx. 1 mile.
- 3 Towpath changes sides to the canal at Ganny Lock, continue on the towpath.
- 4 Towpath changes sides to the canal at North Cut, continue on the towpath.
- 5 Towpath changes sides to the canal, continue on canal towpath to Cromwell Bottom Nature Reserve.

Cromwell Bottom has a network of paths to explore some linking directly back to the canal network. Follow the same simple route back to Brighouse Station.
