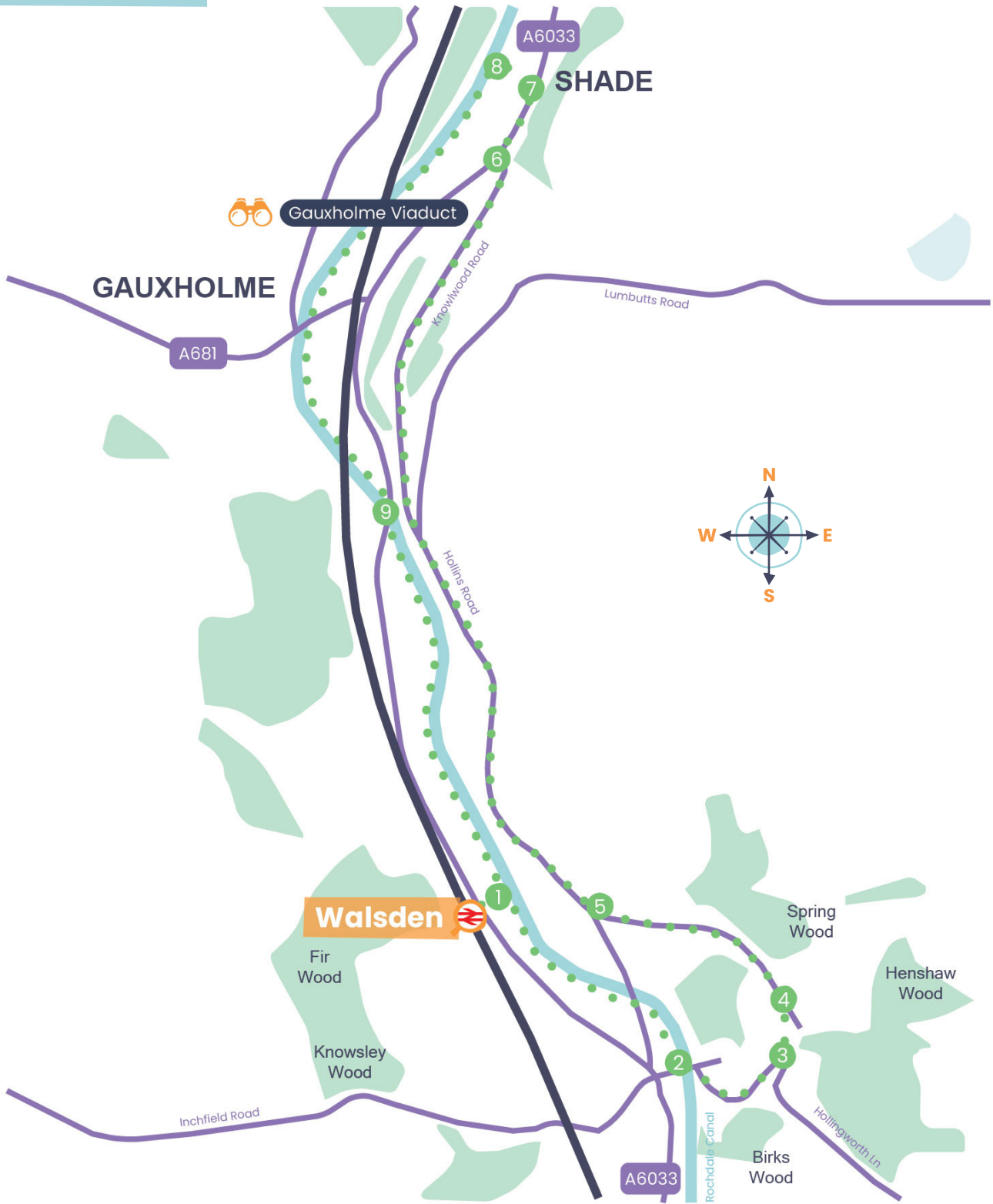









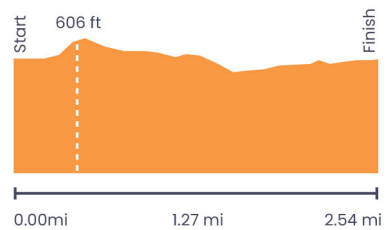
# Walsden Walk

## Walsden Walk

An easy walk around the Walsden area taking in the Rochdale Canal, Walsden Water, historic buildings and views of the steep sided valleys.

- 1 Exit Walsden Station on the east side and use the Zebra Crossing to access Alma Road. Turn right onto the Rochdale Canal towpath and follow for approx. ½ mile.
- 2 At St Peters Gate exit the towpath left over the bridge and follow the road climbing slightly through the woodland passing the church.
- 3 Before the road u turns, take the footpath to the left climbing slightly to Heather Bank
- 4 Follow Heather Bank, this becomes Henshaw Road.
- 5 At the junction turn right onto Hollins Road, follow Hollins Road for approx. ½ mile. Look for a right fork onto Knowlwood Road and follow to the junction with the A6033.
- 6 Use the zebra crossing and turn right heading north along the A6033.
- 7 Turn left onto Oak Street and follow until the end of the road and entry point onto the Rochdale Canal.
- 8 Turn left and follow the canal towpath for approx. ¾ mile until you reach the A6033.
- 9 Cross the A6033 and locate the canal towpath, follow the towpath south back to Point 1 Alma Road and access to Walsden Station.
